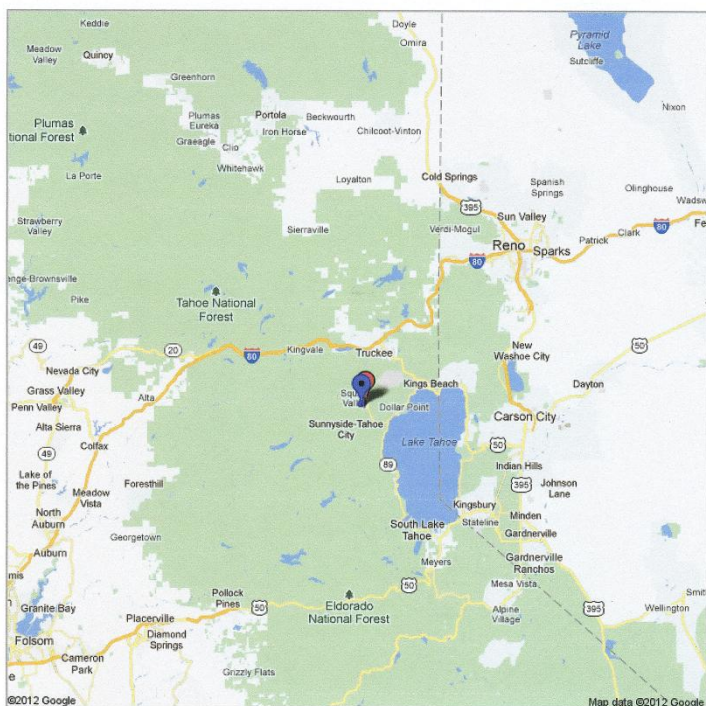

From CA 89 South, exit Squaw Creek Rd. (Olympic Rings mark your turnoff). At the "Y" intersection, keep to your left. Continue past the guard house and keep an eye out for the free parking lot that will be on your right, or continue to the entrance for paid valet parking. Note: Free parking lot is only a short walking distance to the hotel.
